

# Scholarship Application

This application is for ALL UCC students who wish to apply for a scholarship. You only need to submit **one application for all scholarships**. All scholarship applicants must be:

- enrolled in a **degree or certificate program**
- enrolled for at least **6 credits**

In addition, many scholarships **require that you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)**. You can complete your FAFSA online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Your application will not be reviewed until you have first been evaluated for all Federal and State grants including Federal Pell Grant, New Jersey Tuition Aid Grant (TAG), and others. You may receive a combination of Federal and State grants and scholarships. You can view your application status online at any time using E-Services which you can access from our website at [www.ucc.edu](http://www.ucc.edu).

Please note that some scholarships can only be applied to tuition and fees in excess of your grants and scholarships. As a result, you may be eligible for a scholarship but not able to receive one because your grants and scholarships exceed your tuition and fees. All scholarships are contingent upon funds availability and distributed on a first come, first served basis.

Some scholarships require an additional essay and or recommendation. Please submit all essays and recommendations with this application. **Multiple or incomplete applications may not be reviewed.**
