

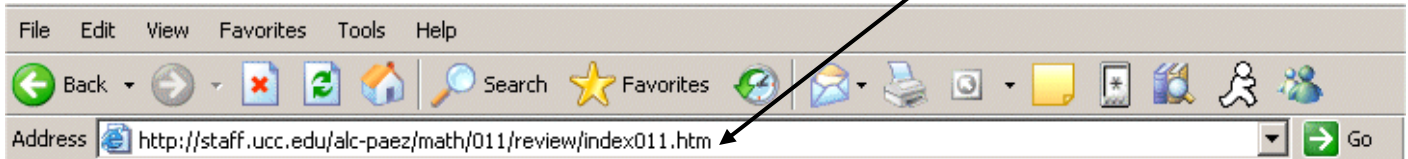


Basic Math: Computational Skills Practice on the Web

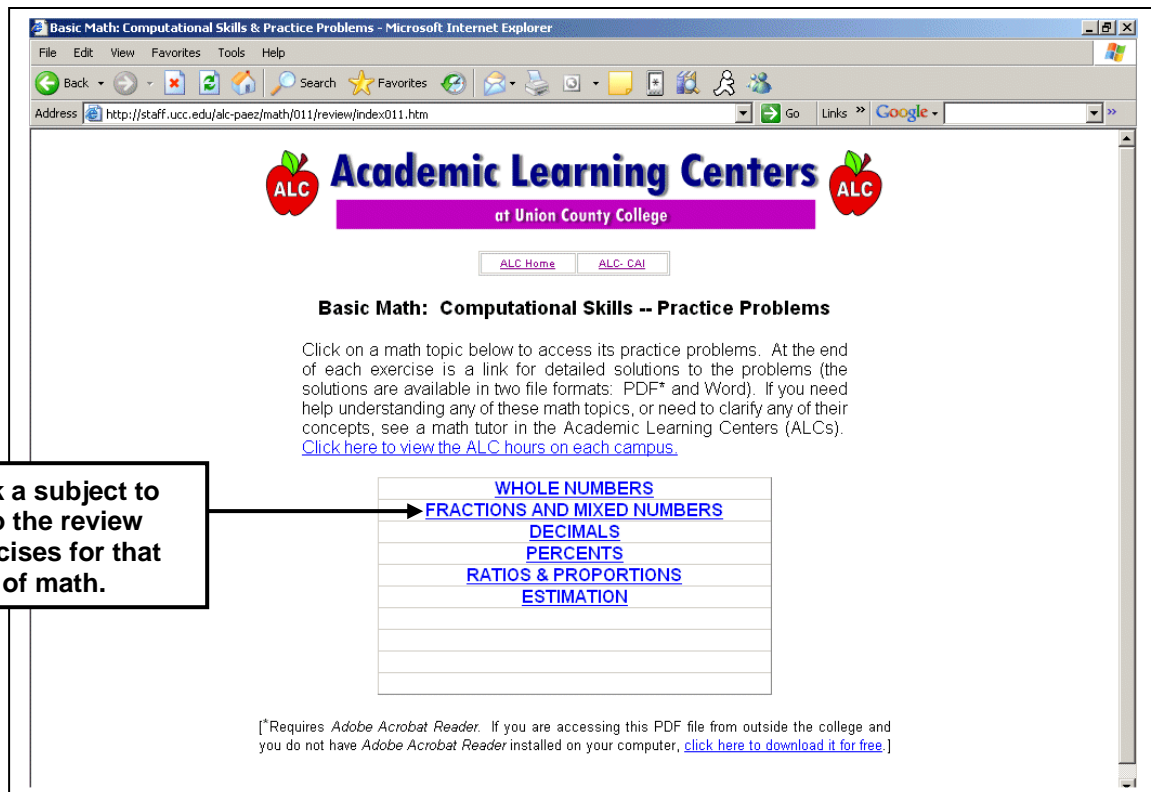
UCC's Academic Learning Center has created a series of online interactive exercises for basic math review (these can also help students prepare for the Basic Skills Test in Arithmetic). Subjects covered are Whole Numbers, Fractions & Mixed Numbers, Decimals, Percents, Ratios & Proportions, and Estimation. To help students understand the math concepts, included are response feedback and complete guided solutions to each math problem. Students can access this material in the ALC computer labs, or via any internet connection outside the college.

I. TO ACCESS THE EXERCISES FROM ANY COMPUTER WITH AN INTERNET CONNECTION:

1. Open the internet browser (*Internet Explorer, Netscape, etc.*).
2. In the address bar, type **http://staff.ucc.edu/alc-paez/math/011/review/index011.htm** (you must type this exactly right in order for it to work).
3. Press the Enter key on the keyboard.



4. The website will appear on the screen.

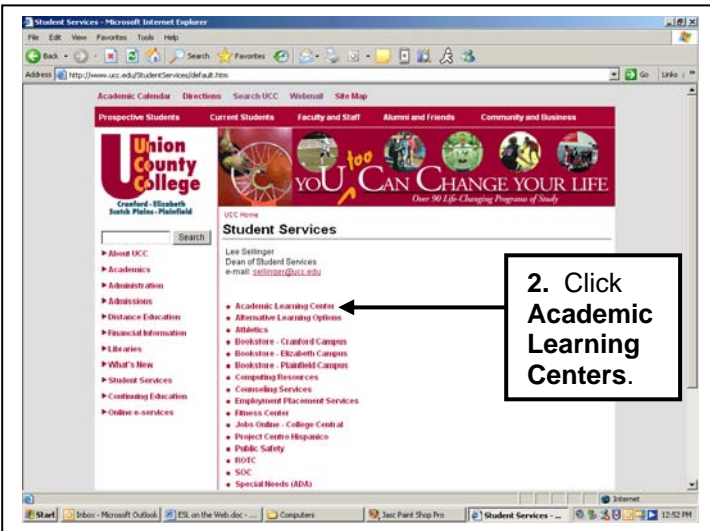


II. TO ACCESS THE EXERCISES FROM THE UCC HOME PAGE (<http://www.ucc.edu>):

1. Click **Academics.**



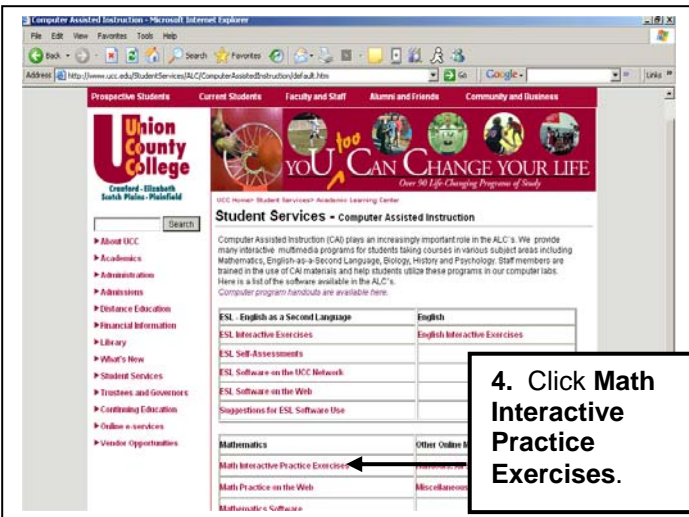
2. Click **Academic Learning Centers.**
