

Emergency Standard Endorsement and Substitute Credentialing Information

Emergency Certification:

- County of residence or school of employment sponsors interpreter
- Interpreter provides EIPA certification showing 3.0 or higher
- Check for \$75.00 to Commissioner of Education
- High school/college/GED diploma

Standard Certification:

- Interpreter applies through county of residence, Office of Education, or online
- Interpreter provides:
 - ❖ EIPA certificate 3.0 or higher
 - ❖ Documentation of AA degree or RID/NAD certification
 - ❖ Documentation of completion of 15 credit hour coursework sequence (EIPDC will provide letter of evidence)
 - ❖ Check for \$75.00 to Commissioner of Education

Substitute Interpreters:

- Amendment passed October, effective September 2006
- School sponsors through county of residence
- **One application to work throughout the state of New Jersey**

Applying as a substitute:

- Substitute interpreters must have:
 - ❖ EIPA certificate 3.0 or higher
 - ❖ High school/GED/college diploma
 - ❖ Check for \$75.00
