DYNED

DYNED is an *ESL* listening program with voice recording/playback and speech recognition capabilities. You must use the mouse in order to get around the program.

I. STARTING THE PROGRAM

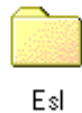
1. Double-click **Lab Applications** folder on the Windows desktop.



2. Double-click **ALC Applications** folder.



3. Double-click **EsI** folder.



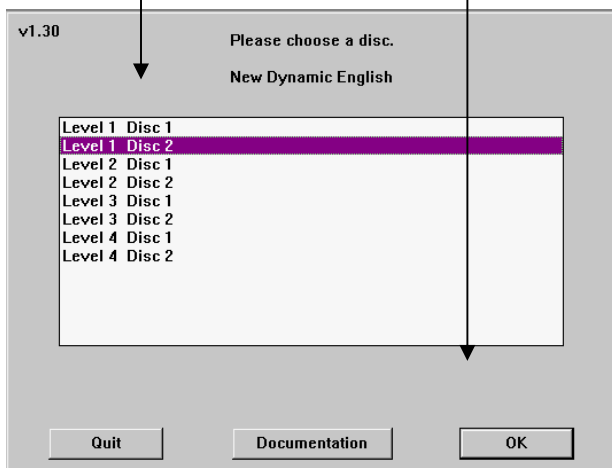
4. Double-click **Dyned** folder.



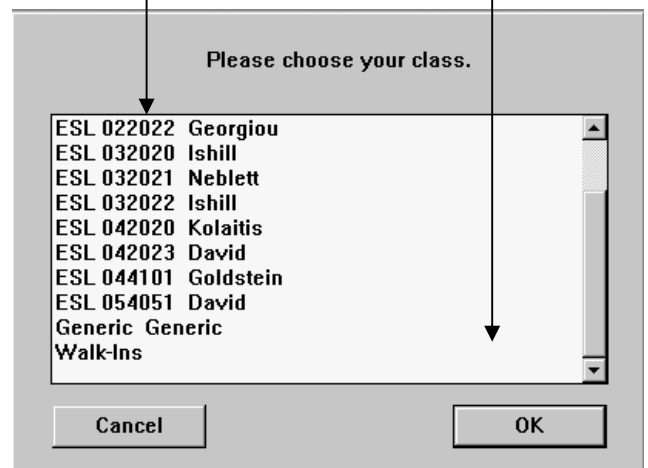
5. Double-click the **Dyned** section you wish to use.
- No disks are required for *New Dynamic English* (Level 1, Disk 1 through Level 4, Disk 4).
 - Disks *are* required for *Dynamic Classics* (Alice in Wonderland, etc.) and for *Dynamic Business English*.
 - **For this tutorial, we will use New Dynamic English.**



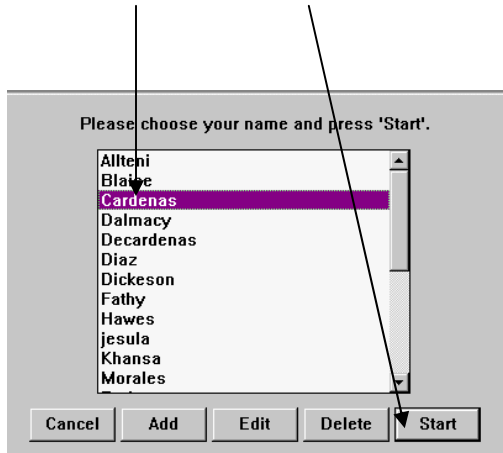
6. Select the Level and Disk; then, double-click it or click OK.



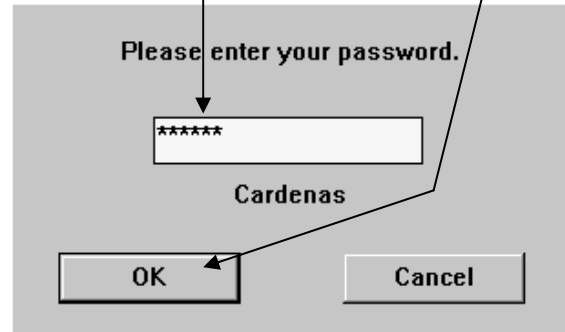
7. Select your class; then, double click it or click OK (if your class does not appear, choose Walk-Ins).



8. Select your last name from the list (if you choose Walk-Ins, you will see Student 1, Student 2, etc. instead of last names); then, double-click it or click Start.



9. Type in your *first* name as your password (if you choose Walk-Ins, the password will be the number of the student you choose from the list – for example, 1, 2, and so on).
10. Click OK, or press Enter.



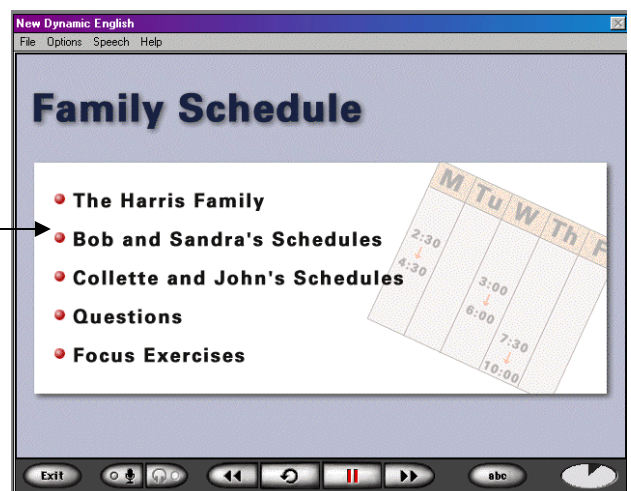
11. Click English Only.



12. Click a topic.

13. Click on an exercise.

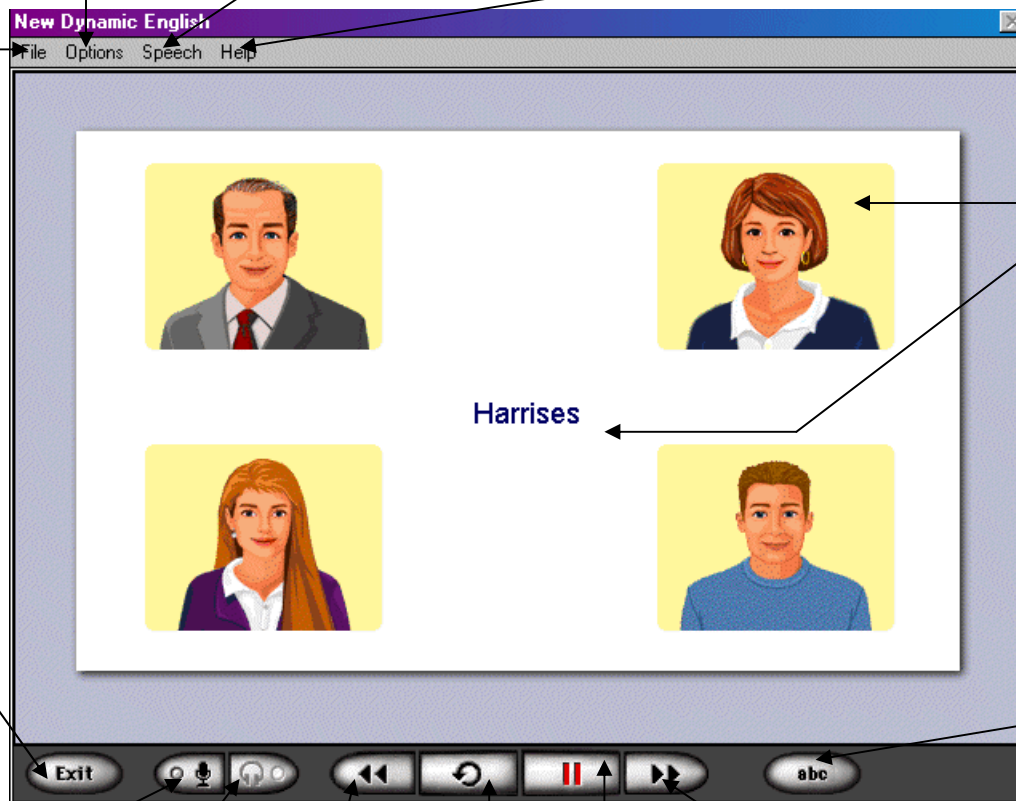
II. GETTING AROUND THE PROGRAM

Options – to view *Student Records*, *Glossary*, to adjust volume Levels and length of pause, and to turn on the Text for the entire exercise.

Speech – to turn on (or off) the *Speech Recognition* function, and to adjust the *Speech Recognition Level* of difficulty (Note that *Speech Recognition* is available in only some sections of the program).

Help – for general Dyned *Help* and *Study Tips*.

File – to see information about the *Dyned* company, and to *Exit* the program.



Click **Exit** to return to the previous menu.

Click on *pictures* or *words* on the main screen to *respond* to *questions*.

Click here to *record* your *voice*.

Click here to *play* *back* your recorded *voice*.

Click here to *review* *previous* *sentences*.

Click here to *repeat* *the* *last* *sentence*.

Click here to *pause* the program (a flashing green arrow appears when program is paused).

Click here to *fast forward* through the program.

Click here to see the *text* of the *sentence* you hear.
