

TUITION-FREE COMMUNITY COLLEGE NOW AVAILABLE

How Community College Opportunity Grants make Community College affordable:

Community College Opportunity Grants are awards that will pay the costs of tuition and approved educational fees not already covered by other available grants applied to the student's account for New Jersey residents with the following annual adjusted gross incomes (AGI):

AGI Between \$0 and \$65,000

CCOG will pay the full maximum award available at the college

AGI Between \$65,001 and \$80,000

CCOG will pay up to one-half of the maximum award available at the college

CCOG will pay up to one-third of the maximum award available at the college





Who is eligible for tuition-free Community College?

Community College Opportunity Grants are available to students who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be a New Jersey resident with a total household adjusted gross income between \$0 \$100,000
- Complete the FAFSA or NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application by applicable state deadlines
- Enroll in at least six (6) credits per semester at any of New Jersey's community colleges during the Spring and/or Fall semesters
- Have no prior college degree
- Make satisfactory academic progress
