NEW! Colonial Era of the United States: the Birth of a Continent (12 hrs.)

Journey through the rich and complex history of North Americafrom the diverse indigenous cultures that thrived across the continent to the bold age of European exploration and conquest. This course dives into the dramatic rise of Spanish and Portuguese empires in Latin America, the foundations of English colonies in the Chesapeake and New England, and the expansion into the Mid-Atlantic. Uncover the evolution of colonial life in the 17th and 18th centuries, the rise of French power in Canada and the Mississippi Valley, and the fierce colonial rivalries that exploded into war. The course culminates with the mounting tensions of the 1760s, setting the stage for revolution. Perfect for history enthusiasts, this course brings early American history to life with compelling narratives and critical insights.

The decade of the 1950's became known as the "golden age" of science-fiction film.
