## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The American Sign Language and Deaf Studies certificate program is designed for individuals who currently have a college degree and are interested in the fields of Deaf Studies, linguistics, communications, psychology, social work, rehabilitation, education of the Deaf or other related areas. The normal time to complete this program, based on the recommended sequence, is two years (four part-time semesters).

### PROGRAM COSTS

Based on the 2019-2020 cost of attendance, this program will cost \$9,107 if completed within normal time. This figure includes course fees (where applicable) and an estimate for books and supplies.
