PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Emergency Medical Studies certificate program is intended for students who are interested in helping and treating patients in an emergency setting outside of the hospital. Prospective students should have an interest in pathophysiology, basic medical concepts, and patient care. The normal time to complete this program, based on the recommended sequence, is one year (two full-time semesters).

PROGRAM COSTS

Based on the 2019-2020 cost of attendance, this program will cost \$6,882 if completed within normal time. This figure includes course fees (where applicable) and an estimate for books and supplies. Living expenses, transportation, and other miscellaneous expenses are not included in these calculations. Please note that this information is subject to change.
