Are you...?

A US Citizen or Eligible Non-Citizen

Complete the 2018-2019 FAFSA and satisfy all eligibility requirements by February 15, 2019:

- ✓ Have a valid social security number
- Enroll in a degree seeking or certificate program
- ✓ Register for Selective Service (males age 18-25)
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress
- ✓ Have a high school diploma or GED

An Undocumented or DACA student

Complete the 2018-2019 NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application and satisfy all eligibility requirements by February 15, 2019:

- ✓ Have attended a NJ high school for at least 3 years
- Graduate from a NJ high school or receive the equivalent of a high school diploma in NJ
- ✓ Register for Selective Service (males age 18-25)
- ✓ File an affidavit stating that you have filed or will file an application to legalize your immigration status as soon as you are eligible.

Note: To satisfy all State requirements, students must create a NJFAMS Account.



To be eligible for the Community College Opportunity Grant you must satisfy these requirements:

- ✓ File the FAFSA or the State of New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application.
- ✓ Have a 2016 Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) not less than \$0 or more than \$45,000.

Dependent student: Only the parental AGI as reported on the FAFSA or NJ Alternative Application will be considered.

Independent student and spouse (if applicable): AGI as reported on the FAFSA or NJ Alternative Application will be considered.

- ✓ Enroll for 6 to 18 credits
- ✓ Be a Union County resident for at least one year
- ✓ Maintain satisfactory academic progress (for students enrolled in the Fall 2018 term)

Other Circumstances:

You may also be eligible for Community College Opportunity Grant if:

- ✓ You were not enrolled for the Fall 2018 term or were not maintaining satisfactory academic progress
- ✓ You do not already have an associate or bachelor's degree
- ✓ You reside outside Union County but were enrolled in and attended an approved Out-of-County program prior to/during the Fall 2018 term

Filing the FAFSA or NJ Alternative Application will complete your application for this grant. There are no additional application forms.
