Career Options and Potential Earnings, based on an Associate degree:

Computer Support Specialist

- Entry level salary: \$32,000 - \$37,000
- Average NJ salary (all experience levels): \$59,150

Computer/Network Support Technician

- Entry Level salary: \$35,000 - \$40,000
- Average NJ salary (all experience levels): \$83,260

Cybersecurity Intern

IT Systems Security Intern

- May be paid or unpaid (for college credit)
- Paid Cybersecurity Interns earn on average, \$16-\$22/hour

**Supplementing with appropriate certifications may result in salary increases. Recommended Certifications for Cybersecurity careers include, but are not limited to CompTIA Security+ and ISC2 Certified Information Systems Security Professional (CISSP).*
