Career Options and Potential Earnings, based on this Certificate with a prior Associate degree:

American Sign Language Interpreter

Educational Interpreter

(specific education requirements vary per company between Associate & Bachelor level)

- Entry Level: \$41,000-\$47,000
- Average for New Jersey (all experience levels): \$71,960

Teacher Assistant/Aide (with Sign Language training/certification)

- Entry Level: \$23,000-\$28,000
- Average for New Jersey (all experience levels): \$30,320

Additional requirements may include passing the New Jersey Division of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DDHH) Screening, completing certification by the National Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf, or passing the Educational Interpreter Performance Assessment.

Supplementing with appropriate certifications may result in salary increases.
