Career Options and Potential Earnings, based on a Certificate:

Graphic Artist/Designer

- Hourly Pay Range: \$11-\$28
- Average Pay: \$16

Graphic Artist

- Hourly Pay Range: \$11-\$18
- Average Pay: \$14

Production Artist (Graphic Arts)

- Hourly Pay Range: \$15-\$33
- Average Pay: \$21

Multimedia Specialist

- Hourly Pay Range: \$14-\$26
- Average Pay: \$19

Typically, a Bachelors degree is required for most Graphic Designer positions. Some companies do not have specific degree requirements, so you may be able to obtain a Graphic Design position before degree completion, with strong skills in Adobe Creative Suite and a strong portfolio.
