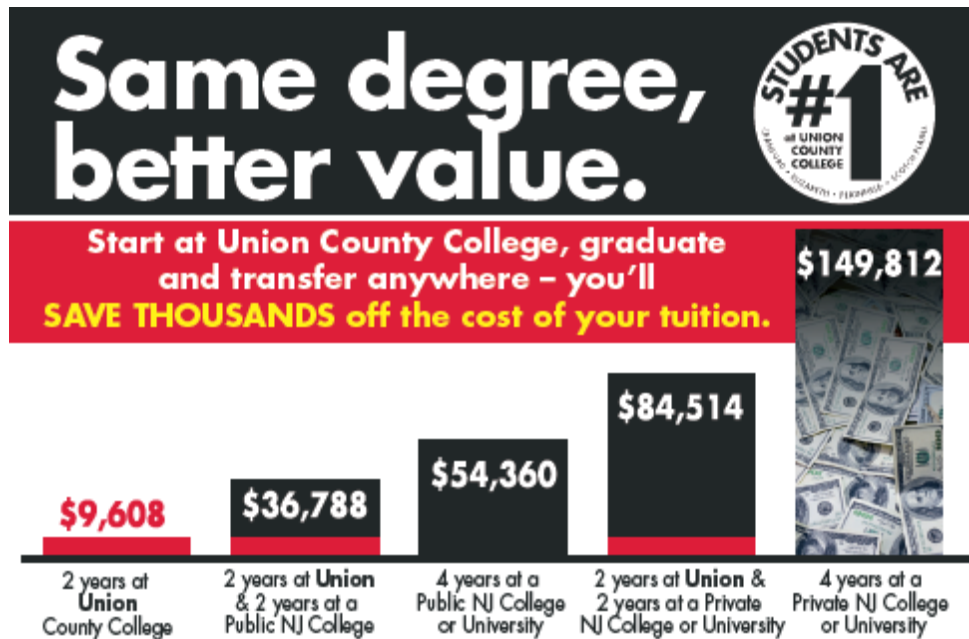


## Transfer Information



Earning an Associate degree ([A.A.](#) and [A.S.](#)) at Union County College is **the equivalent of the first two years of a four-year college or university degree.**

### Using NJ Transfer

NJ Transfer is designed to provide successful transfer from New Jersey community colleges to New Jersey four-year colleges and universities. At the NJ Transfer website, [www.njtransfer.org](http://www.njtransfer.org) students can:

- Learn which courses to select at Union County College to align them with a transfer institution
- Discover how these courses will satisfy the degree and major requirements at New Jersey four-year colleges and universities
- Find links to New Jersey two and four-year colleges and universities
- Obtain information on admissions, financial aid, and scholarship, and transfer recruitment events throughout the State

### Instant Decision Days

Union County College holds Instant Decision Days every semester for potential graduates who are interested in transferring to a four-year institution within New Jersey. Instant Decision Day allows potential graduates to apply, interview and receive an admissions decision all in a single day! Most schools waive the application fee. Colleges include but are not limited to: NJIT, Drew, FDU, William Paterson University, NJCU, Montclair State University and Seton Hall University.

### Transfer Admissions Information Sessions

Representatives from institutions visit with Union County College students on campus to discuss admissions requirements, transfer credits, tuition & fees. Universities and Colleges include but are not limited to: Columbia University, Rutgers University, Montclair University, and Princeton University.

## **Transfer Fair**

During the fall and spring semesters, Transfer Fairs are held to assist in planning for transfer upon completion of an associate degree. These fairs provide the opportunity for students to meet with representatives from four-year colleges and universities to discuss their programs and the application process, as well as specific admissions requirements. Representatives also provide scholarship information and details on campus life at each college or university.
