PRE-REQUISITES: Presented by 1st day of class.

2. Medical Clearance Form – Students must be medically cleared by their healthcare professional. See posted form.
3. Covid Vaccinated- Students must provide full proof of vaccination.
4. Clearance for Fit-Testing – Students must have a medical professional attest to the student's ability to be fit tested for N-95 masks that are required for required field observations. See posted form.
