## 2015 Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act Report Union County College

Any coeducational institution of higher education that participates in Title IV, the federal student aid program, and has an intercollegiate athletics program, must comply with the Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act ("EADA") by disclosing information about varsity sports teams and the financial resources and personnel that the institution dedicates to those teams.
