A copy of the credential if you were home schooled in a State where State law requires you to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent).

A copy of the credential if you were homeschooled in a State where State law does not require you to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript, or the equivalent, signed by your parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses you completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
