

**Response Protocols for Students Who Test Positive for COVID-19, Who Have Been Exposed to COVID-19, or With COVID-19 Symptoms**

<b>EVENT</b>	<b>NOTIFICATIONS</b>	<b>RESPONSE</b>
<p>Student tests positive for COVID-19</p>	<p><b>REPORT POSITIVE CASES TO THE COLLEGE IMMEDIATELY</b></p> <p><b>Call or Text 908-514-8261, Email <a href="mailto:covid@ucc.edu">covid@ucc.edu</a></b></p> <p><b>If student notifies Instructor or other Employee, then that individual must notify Public Safety IMMEDIATELY at 908-709-7152.</b></p>	<p>If Student no longer has symptoms, he/she can return to campus after:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 10 days have passed since the date of their first positive COVID-19 diagnostic test.</li> </ul> <p>Instructors will provide remote instruction to quarantined students where possible.</p>
<p>Student has close contact with an individual who tested positive for COVID-19</p>	<p><b>REPORT CLOSE CONTACT CASES TO THE COLLEGE IMMEDIATELY</b></p> <p><b>Call or Text 908-514-8261 Email <a href="mailto:covid@ucc.edu">covid@ucc.edu</a></b></p> <p><b>If student notifies Instructor or other Employee, then that individual must notify Public Safety IMMEDIATELY at 908-709-7152.</b></p>	<p>Close contact is defined as within six (6) feet for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.</p> <p>Students who have come into close contact with an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 need to stay home for 14 days after their last exposure to that person.</p> <p>However, anyone who has had close contact with someone with COVID-19 and who meets the following criteria does <b>NOT</b> need to stay home.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has COVID-19 illness within the previous 3 months <b>and</b></li> <li>• Has recovered <b>and</b></li> <li>• Remains without COVID-19 symptoms (for example, cough, shortness of breath)</li> </ul> <p>Instructors will provide remote instruction to quarantined students where possible.</p>
<p>Student exhibits COVID-19 symptoms</p>	<p><b>REPORT SYMPTOMS TO THE COLLEGE IMMEDIATELY</b></p> <p><b>Call or Text 908-514-8261, Email <a href="mailto:covid@ucc.edu">covid@ucc.edu</a></b></p> <p><b>If student notifies Instructor or other Employee, then that individual must notify Public Safety IMMEDIATELY at 908-709-7152.</b></p>	<p>Student needs to stay home, or the Instructor needs to send the student home. Student can return to campus after:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 10 days since symptoms first appeared <b>AND</b></li> <li>• 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medicines <b>AND</b></li> <li>• Other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving.</li> </ul> <p>Instructors will provide remote instruction to quarantined students where possible.</p> <p>Because some of the symptoms of flu (and other illnesses) and COVID-19 are similar, it may be hard to tell the difference between them based on symptoms alone. Follow protocols when symptoms occur that are outside of your usual illness patterns.</p>

Faculty and staff should not send out notifications to other faculty members, staff or students as the Dean of Students and/or Human Resources will handle all notifications.

If a positive case is enrolled in their in-person course, instructors are notified; however, the student will not be identified. Instructors will not need to take any further action unless directed to do so by Academic Affairs. The class can continue in the face-to-face modality, as previously scheduled, except for those faculty or students who meet the criteria for exposure and isolation.
