#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The Interpreting Spoken Language certificate program prepares its graduates to become court interpreters. Fluency in both English and at least one other language is required for admission to the program. Students will develop their interpreting ability with courses that focus on consecutive interpreting, simultaneous interpreting, and sight translation. The normal time to complete this program, based on the recommended sequence, is one year (two full-time semesters).

#### **PROGRAM COSTS**

Based on the 2019-2020 cost of attendance, this program will cost \$6,762 if completed within normal time. This figure includes course fees (where applicable) and an estimate for books and supplies. Living expenses, transportation, and other miscellaneous expenses are not included in these calculations. Please note that this information is subject to change.
