PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Photovoltaic certificate program provides academic, technical, and hands-on experience to prepare graduates for entry into the workforce and further on the job-training in PV industry related job functions. The normal time to complete this program, based on the recommended sequence, is 1.5 years or three semesters (one full-time and two part-time).

PROGRAM COSTS

Based on the 2019-2020 cost of attendance, this program will cost \$7,973 if completed within normal time. This figure includes course fees (where applicable) and an estimate for books and supplies. Living expenses, transportation, and other miscellaneous expenses are not included in these calculations. Please note that this information is subject to change.
