PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Paralegal Studies certificate of achievement program is designed to prepare graduates for a variety of paralegal job opportunities. The utilization of paralegals improves the efficiency, economy and availability of legal services. A paralegal performs substantive legal work under the direct supervision of an attorney. The normal time to complete this program, based on the recommended sequence, is one year (two full-time semesters).

PROGRAM COSTS

Based on the 2019-2020 cost of attendance, this program will cost \$6,697 if completed within normal time. This figure includes course fees (where applicable) and an estimate for books and supplies. Living expenses, transportation, and other miscellaneous expenses are not included in these calculations. Please note that this information is subject to change.
