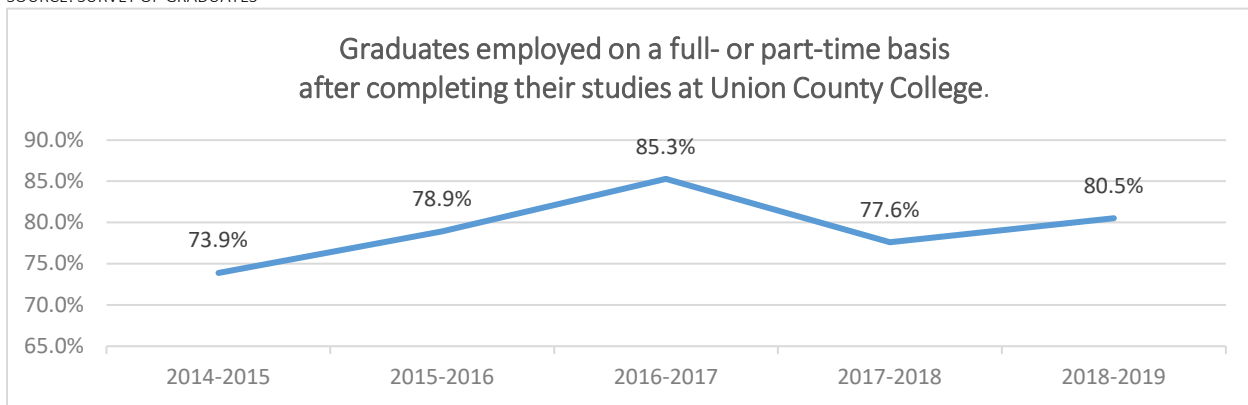


## Education and Career Outcomes

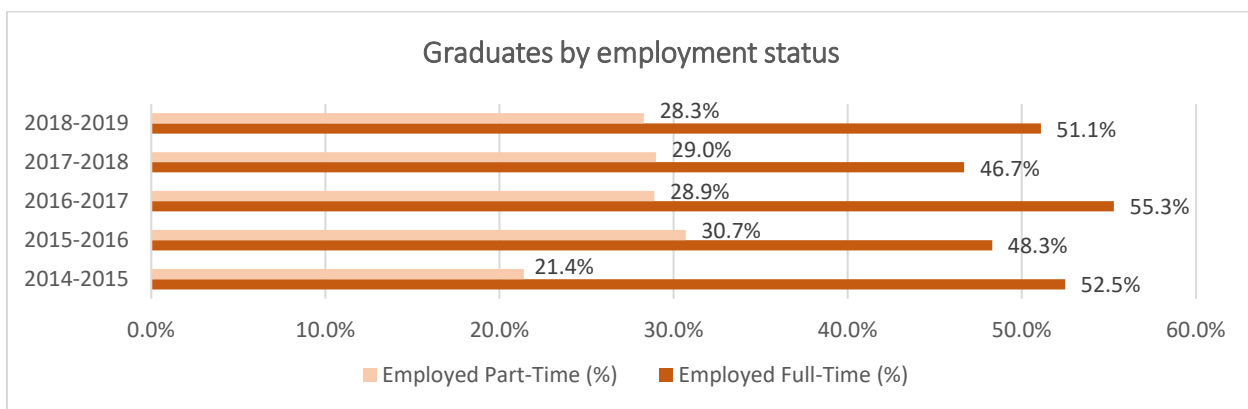
