Displaced Homemakers transitioning into the workforce

What is a displaced homemaker?

A displaced homemaker is someone who has worked in the home for a number of years and through the death, disablement, or divorce of a spouse is now the primary source of household income. They may be underemployed and unable to support themselves and/or their children. Through New Jersey's Displaced Homemaker (DH) programs, they may earn or upgrade their skills for transition into the paid labor market.

What training is available?
