- CAD Operator / AutoCAD Technician
 - Entry Level: \$32,000 - \$37,000
 - Average for New Jersey (all experience levels): \$57,204
- Drafters
 - Entry Level: \$33,000-\$38,000
 - Average for New Jersey (all experience levels)
 - Architectural/Civil Drafter: \$54,260
 - Electrical/Electronics Drafter: \$64,600
 - Mechanical Drafter: \$66,160
 - Other Drafters: \$56,800
